

Village of Oostburg Residents

The Following Recycling Guide will become effective **November 1, 2011:**

PLEASE NOTE: Furniture, appliances, electronic items, Freon items, cement, tires and construction materials will NOT be collected in the normal garbage pick-up on Fridays. See below for proper disposal of items other than household trash and recyclable items.

You should place your trash (MAXIMUM OF 1 CUBIC YARD - OR APPROXIMATELY 4 GARBAGE BAGS) on the curb at the end of your driveway by 7:00 A.M. on Friday. If a holiday falls in a week before a regularly scheduled Friday pick-up, the pick-up will be that Saturday. Your recyclable items should be packaged as follows:

PLACE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS, MIXED TOGETHER, IN A CLEAR "BLUE" RECYCLING BAG:

TIN & STEEL CANS	All Empty Cans & All Aerosol Cans that are punctured	RINSE CLEAN Flattening Optional Puncture Aerosol Cans	Containers, Aerosol Cans & Paint Cans with Product Not Emptied
PLASTIC	Milk, Yogurt, Soda and Detergent Bottles, other Bottles Marked: 1-7.	RINSE CLEAN Remove And Discard Lids In Trash. Crush Bottles.	Plastic Oil Bottles, Food Containers, Styrofoam, Plastic Cups and Film Hard Plastic (toys, pails, etc.) Medicine Bottles 7 Syringes

OTHER RECYCLABLE ITEMS NOT IN A "BLUE" RECYCLING BAG:

MATERIALS	WHAT TO RECYCLE	CLEANING & PREPARATION	WHAT CAN'T BE RECYCLED
PAPER	Newspaper Junk Mail Magazines	Place in Grocery Bag, plastic bin or box. Bundles no larger than 8" high	Wax Coated Paper
CARDBOARD	All Cardboard Boxes	Flatten boxes cut into 3x3 pieces bundle and place in plastic bin or box	

GENERAL RULES:

- Household trash must be placed in clear plastic bag. Black plastic bags are not accepted.
- Glass, plastic, aluminum and tin cans can be mixed together in a clear blue plastic recycling bag.
- Newspapers magazines and cardboard must be tied in bundles or put in grocery bags
- **Constructions materials and Freon Items will NOT be collected. For information on disposal of construction materials (2x4's, drywall, metal, etc.) and Freon Items (refrigerators, air conditioners, etc.) you may call Veolia Environmental Services (459-6030) or Carl Nyhof Trucking (564-3793) to inquire about disposal arrangements and fees.**
- Yard waste, trees and brush are **NOT** included in the curbside pick up. These items can be disposed at the Village of Oostburg dumpsites designated for such waste at no charge.
- The following items will **NOT** be collected: Heavy refuse such as furniture, appliances, cement, tires, batteries, oil and hazardous waste. You may call Veolia Environmental Services (459-6030), Carl Nyhof Trucking (564-3793) or Carlton Automotive (564-3433) to inquire about disposal arrangements and fees.
- Electronic items will **NOT** be collected, including, but not limited to: Microwaves, Televisions, computer monitors, desktop and laptop computers, desktop printers, fax machines, computer peripherals, keyboards, mice, speakers, DVD players, VCR's, digital video recorders and cell phones. The village has contracted with Zeus Recycling Solutions for semi-annual disposal of these items at no cost to the tax payer. Collection dates are the second Saturday of May and November from 8-11 at the Municipal Building.
