

## VILLAGE OF OOSTBURG DOG OWNERS

Wisconsin Statutes (Sections 95.21(2), 174.05, and 174.07(1)(b)) require all dogs that are 5 (five) months of age or older **MUST** be licensed annually. The owner of the dog must obtain a license **prior to April 1st**, OR, on or before the date the dog becomes 5 (five) months of age.

Evidence that the dog is currently immunized against rabies must be presented before a license can be issued.

**FAILURE TO OBTAIN A LICENSE PRIOR TO THE APRIL 1ST DEADLINE WILL RESULT IN A \$10 LATE FEE.**

A dog license may NOT be transferred from one dog to another.

Spayed or Neutered Dog	\$10.00
Unneutered Male or Unspayed Female Dog	\$17.00

Licenses can be obtained at the office of the Village Clerk, 1140 Minnesota Avenue, or by mail. Please provide the following information when requesting a license:

- Proof of current rabies vaccination
- Owner's name, address, phone number
- Dog's name, color, breed, gender
- Stamped, self-addressed envelope (when applying by mail)
