SEWER RATES – Effective 01/16/2019

Monthly Service Charge of \$8.76 per equivalent residential unit (ERU) plus volume charge of \$13.12 per 1000 gallons

- (1) **CATEGORY A** shall be those sanitary sewer users who discharge normal domestic strength wastewater with concentrations of biochemical oxygen demand (BOD) no greater than 200 mg/l and suspended solids no greater than 175 mg/l.
- (2) **CATEGORY B** shall be those sanitary sewer users who discharge wastewater with concentrations in excess of 200 mg/l of BOD and 175 mg/l of suspended solids. Users whose wastewater exceeds the concentrations for any one of these parameters shall be in Category B. The minimum Category B charge will be based on a concentration of not less than 200 mg/l of BOD, 270 mg/l of suspended solids and 7 mg/l phosphorus.

The Category B sewer service charge shall be computed in accordance with the formula presented below:

$$C = F + (V \times C_v) + .00834 V [(B \times C_B) + (S \times C_S)] + (P \times CP)$$

C = Charge to sewer user for collection and treatment of wastewater

F = Fixed charge per billing period

B = Concentration of BOD in mg/l in the wastewater (concentration minus 200 mg/l equals B)

S = Concentration of suspended solids in mg/l in the wastewater (concentration minus 175 mg/l equals S)

P = Concentration of Phosphorus in mg/l in the wastewater (concentration minus 7 mg/l equals P)
V = Wastewater volume in 1,000 gallons for the billing period
C_V = Cost per 1,000 gallons
C_B = Cost per pound of BOD
C_S = Cost per pound of suspended solids
CP = Cost per pound of Phosphorus
.00834 = Conversion factor

- (3) **SETTING RATES AND CHARGES.** Rates for determination of Volumetric Charges and Fixed Charges per ERU shall be set for all user classes. Rates and Fixed Charges shall be set by resolution of the Village Board. A Sewer Service Charge and Fee Schedule shall be published by the Village Clerk's office, and all charge calculations shall be based on the rates shown on the then-current fee schedule. All rates and fixed charges shall be reviewed at least every two years, and amended as necessary to reflect costs to comply with applicable state and federal laws. Volumetric rates shall be per every one thousand gallons of wastewater discharged by the user. Fixed charges are established per ERU based upon the size of the meter and customer class. Category B rates shall include additional surcharges for BOD, suspended solids and phosphorus in excess of Category A thresholds.

A late payment of 3% of the water charges and 10% of the sewer charges will be added to bills not paid by the due date. Delinquent accounts on November 15th of each year will be placed on the tax roll with a 10% service charge. Failure to receive bill is no excuse for non-payment.
