### 4.01 Provisions Of State Law Adopted By Reference

Except as otherwise specifically provided in this code, the statutory provisions in § 66.119 of the Wisconsin Statutes, describing and defining procedure with respect for violations other than vehicles and traffic of Chapter 3 of these ordinances, are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this Code as if fully set forth herein. Any act required to be performed or prohibited by any statute incorporated herein by reference is required or prohibited by this code. Any further amendments, revisions or modifications of the statutes incorporated herein are intended to be made a part of this code in order to secure uniform statewide regulation of the procedure as to citations for certain ordinance violations.

### 4.02 Form MSC 1

The Wisconsin Uniform Municipal Citation is hereby adopted as hereinafter set forth. Any future amendments, revisions or modifications of this form done by the County of Sheboygan is intended to be made a part of this code in order to secure uniform countywide administration of citations for certain ordinance violations.

### 4.03 Stipulation Of Guilt Or No Contest

Stipulation of Guilt or No Contest may be made by persons of which a citation has been issued for violation of an ordinance. Stipulation shall conform to the form contained in § 66.119(3) of the Wis. Stats. It may be accepted within ten (10) days of the date of the alleged violation. Stipulations may be accepted by the Clerk of Courts of Sheboygan County, Wisconsin.

### 4.04 Deposit

Any person stipulating guilt or no contest under subsection 4.03 of this section must make the deposit required under § 66.119 as determine under subsection 4.05. Deposits may be brought or mailed to the Clerk of Courts office of Sheboygan County, Wisconsin as directed by the arresting officer. Receipts shall be given for cash deposits.

#### 4.06 Forfeitures In Treasury

Any officer accepting deposits or forfeited penalties under this chapter shall deliver them to the Sheboygan County Clerk of Courts within twenty (20) days after receipt.
